Purpose

Explore and identify 'corporate' and personal values and vision.

Create a new mission statement and 'buy In' for your company

Encourage creativity and 'out of the box' thinking through targeted, structured 'play' and practical hands on exercises.

Motivate and empower your workforce

Process

We undertake an Initial research exercise into your company's current values, functions and desired vision. We do this through a combination of qualitative research (interviews) with staff and looking at existing ethos and mission statements. We will produce a detailed report outlining recommendations for training and workshops, after which we will develop and deliver bespoke workshop and training programmes in consultation with you the client.

The workshops allow delegates to work together as a group using creative and theatre based exercises and techniques. We aim to create a safe environment where views and ideas can be shared openly.

Using structured exercises and 'purposeful' games delegates explore their part in the big picture of your organisation.

Duration: 1-2 days.

Maximum number of delegates: 20-30 (two facilitators)

Payoff

Construct a strengthened vision for the future of your company and encourage group functioning and team work. The value and vision workshops encourage optimum company 'buy In'.

Case Study
